



King's College will guarantee admission, a four-year renewable scholarship, and an additional grant to senior year students of St. John Neumann Regional Academy who apply to King's College based on the following criteria:

Students must have a minimum 2.75 GPA. If a student possesses a minimum GPA of 2.75, they can also apply test optional (omit SAT/ ACT scores). The three academic programs in which King's College requires a higher GPA and an ACT or SAT score for is the Physician Assistant program, the Engineering programs, and the Nursing program. Students who meet the criteria will receive one scholarship ranging from \$18,000 and at maximum \$25,000, which is an annual award renewable each year for up to four years. The Diocese of Scranton High Schools will also receive an additional annual grant in the amount of \$2,500 (up to \$10,000 cumulatively over 4 years).

## Admission to Physician Assistant Studies or Occupational Therapy :

The student must have a 3.40+ recalculated GPA this includes Math, Science, English, History, and Foreign Language full credit classes from freshman year in high school to junior year. If a student does not meet the 3.40+ criteria, they may defer to Criteria B below:

3.10 - 3.19 Scrubbed GPA—Required SAT combined 1090
3.20 - 3.29 Scrubbed GPA—Required SAT combined 1080
3.30 - 3.39 Scrubbed GPA—Required SAT combined 1070
All GPA's 3.10—3.39—Required ACT 23

Students who meet the above criteria will receive, at minimum, a \$20,000 annual award for 4 years which totals \$80,000.

## Admission to Engineering (King's program or 3+2 with Notre Dame/Wash. U.:

The student must have a 3.3 cumulative or weighted GPA. Grades of a 3.00 (85%) or better in math and science classes are highly preferred. Pre-Calculus & Chemistry is required. Physics is highly recommended with a grade of a 3.00 (85%) or better. Students who meet the criteria will receive, at minimum, a \$20,000 award for 4 years which totals \$80,000

## Admission to Nursing:

The student must have a 3.00 cumulative or weighted GPA. Grades of a 3.00 (85%) or better in all math and science classes are highly preferred.
