



The University of Scranton will guarantee admission for bachelor's-level programs (with the exception of programs listed below) to St. John Neumann Regional Academy graduates who have a 3.0 GPA and either a 1080 SAT (EBRW & Math) or a 22 ACT Composite score. **Students who meet the above criteria will receive, at minimum, an annual \$15,000 scholarship with a total value of \$60,000.**

The University of Scranton will guarantee admission to graduates of St. John Neumann Regional Academy for the entry-level programs of Occupational Therapy, Nursing, and Doctor of Physical Therapy with this criteria: Students must have a minimum GPA of 3.50 and either a 1270 SAT (EBRW & Math) or a 27 ACT Composite score. **Students who meet this criteria will receive, at minimum, an annual \$18,000 scholarship with a total value of \$72,000.** In order to qualify for guaranteed admission, students applying to these programs must apply Early Action and complete all application requirements by November 15 of their senior year.
